ITEMS THAT WILL BE COLLECTED

TIRES! Central Mass Mosquito Control Project will be collecting tires for recycling (47 Auburn St)

- Passenger and light truck tires only
- Off rim, no mounted tires will be accepted
- We reserve the right to refuse anything determined to be unsuitable for this program

BATTERIES! Interstate Batteries will be collecting batteries for recycling (47 Auburn St)

- Car batteries and household rechargeable batteries, such as nickel cadmium and lithium ion, will be accepted
- Single use alkaline batteries are safe to be disposed of in your regular trash!

MERCURY! Auburn Board of Health will be collecting mercury containing items for safe recycling (47 Auburn St)

- Fluorescent light bulbs (CFL, tubes, U-shape)
- Mercury containing thermometers and thermostats, hearing aid & button cell batteries

MATTRESSES! Auburn Board of Health will be collecting mattresses for recycling at no cost to residents (47 Auburn St)

- AUBURN RESIDENTS ONLY, must have ID as proof of residence.
- Limit of one mattress and one box spring per household. Must be clean, dry, not soiled, free of mold, bed bugs or other pests.
- Limit of 100 units to be collected, first come first serve. No futons, sofa beds, mattress pads/toppers, infant sleeping pads, air mattresses, or water beds.
- We reserve the right to refuse anything determined to be unsuitable for this program.
