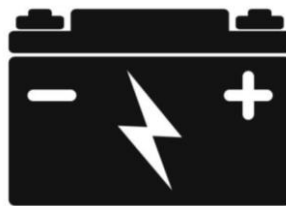

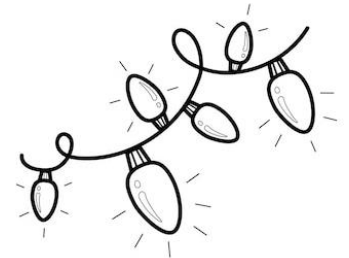

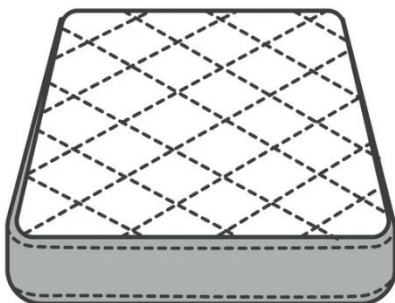

STRING LIGHTS! Auburn Board of Health will be collecting string lights for recycling
MERCURY! Auburn Board of Health will be collecting mercury containing items for safe recycling

- Fluorescent light bulbs (CFL, tubes, U-shape)
- Mercury containing thermometers and thermostats, hearing aid & button cell batteries

SCRAP METAL! Auburn Board of Health will be collecting metal items for recycling

- Miscellaneous metal including aluminum, copper, steel, brass, and iron such as bicycles, washers & dryers, stoves, grills, lawnmowers, and snowblowers
- Any item with a motor must be drained of gasoline. No hazardous waste allowed, including propane tanks.
- We reserve the right to refuse anything determined to be unsuitable for this program

MATTRESSES! Auburn Board of Health will be collecting mattresses for recycling at no cost to residents

- AUBURN RESIDENTS ONLY, must have ID as proof of residence.
- Limit of one mattress and one box spring per household. Must be clean, dry, not soiled, free of mold, bed bugs or other pests.
- Limit of 100 units to be collected, first come first serve. No futons, sofa beds, mattress pads/toppers, infant sleeping pads, air mattresses, or water beds.
- We reserve the right to refuse anything determined to be unsuitable for this program.

SNEAKERS! Auburn Rockets Booster Club will be collecting sneakers as a fundraiser to support student athletic programs

TIRES! Central Mass Mosquito Control Project will be collecting tires for recycling

- AUBURN RESIDENTS ONLY, must have ID as proof of residence.
- Passenger and light truck tires only
- Off rim, no mounted tires will be accepted
- We reserve the right to refuse anything determined to be unsuitable for this program

BATTERIES! Interstate Batteries will be collecting batteries for recycling

- Car batteries and household rechargeable batteries, such as nickel cadmium and lithium ion, will be accepted
- Single use alkaline batteries are safe to be disposed of in your regular trash!
